

1st CONFERENCE of the MIDWESTERN NORDIC ASSEMBLY

RESOLUTION 1.2: *Competition Schedule for the 2021-22 Season*

I. ON THE COMPOSITION OF THE MIDWESTERN COLLEGIATE CUP FOR THE 2021-2022 COMPETITIVE SEASON

1. The Midwestern Collegiate Cup for the 2021-2022 competitive season will consist of five events, these being:
 - 1.1. The Half-Noquemanon Ski Marathon, 24K Skate and 24K Classic, on January 22nd, 2022
 - 1.2. The Mt. Ashwabay Summit Ski Race, 25K Skiathlon, on or about February 5th, 2022
 - 1.3. The Vasaloppet USA, Dala Skate and Vasaloppet Skate, on February 12th, 2022
 - 1.4. The MCSA Nordic Regional Championships, on February 19th-20th, 2022
 - 1.5. The American Birkebeiner, 50K Skate and 55K Classic, on February 26th, 2022
2. All events comprising the Midwestern Collegiate Cup for the 2021-22 competitive season will be recognized as regular season events, with the exception of the MCSA Nordic Regional Championships.

II. ON THE 2021-22 MCSA NORDIC REGIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS

1. Pursuant to Article V, Section 4.3 of the Charter Constituting the Nordic Division of the MCSA, the Midwestern Nordic Assembly hereby designates an event, to be held at the CAVOC in Rhinelander, WI, on February 19th-20th of 2022, as the MCSA Nordic Regional Championships
 - 1.1. If deemed feasible and acceptable by the Northwoods Nordic Ski Club, this event shall consist of a sprint race, whose discipline shall be congruent with that of the sprint scheduled for the 2022 USCSA National Championships, and a broken pursuit, whose cumulative distance shall not exceed 20K, and whose first event will begin with a mass start
 - 1.2. Any Nordic Team which has competed in less than one half of MCSA Nordic regular season events for the 2021-22 season may not:
 - 1.2.1. Score at the MCSA Nordic Regional Championships for the 2021-22 competitive season
 - 1.2.2. Qualify to represent MCSA Nordic at the 2022 USCSA National Championships
2. Pursuant to the concessions of the MCSA and USCSA, the Assembly recognizes that the male and female Nordic Teams from the following institutions will qualify to represent the MCSA at the 2022 USCSA National Championships, irrespective of Article II, Section 1 of this Accord, so long as their qualification does not reduce the number of berths available for contestation at the MCSA Nordic Regional Championships:
 - 2.1. The University of Michigan
 - 2.2. Saint Olaf College.

III. ON PARTICIPATION RACES

1. Pursuant to Article V, Section 4.4 of the Charter Constituting the Nordic Division of the MCSA, the Midwestern Nordic Assembly hereby endorses the designation of the following events not part of the Midwestern Collegiate Cup for the 2021-2022 competitive season as MCSA regular season events for the 2021-2022 competitive season:
 - 1.1. The ABSF Supertour races, the weekend of December 11th, 2021.
